

You can know for sure that you are on your way to Heaven!

Realize that God loves you...

John 3:16, "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life." The Bible teaches that regardless of your background, age, race, or any other factor, God loves you and desires a genuine, personal relationship with you. John 3:17, "For God sent not his Son [Jesus] into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved." God loves us, and He made a way for our salvation through the death of His Son on the cross.

Realize that everyone is a sinner...

Romans 3:23, "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." This simply means that no one is perfect. Surely you must admit that we are all sinners. We have all broken God's commandments. This is called sin, and it separates us from God.

Realize that sin has a price that must be paid...

Romans 6:23, "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." The "wage" or payment for our sin is death, which according to the Bible is eternal separation from God in a place called Hell.

Realize that Jesus Christ died to pay the price for your sin...

Romans 5:8, "But God commendeth [proved] his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." If we choose to accept Jesus Christ into our heart and life, then we do not have to pay the price of death and Hell for our sins; because Jesus paid for all of our sins when He died on the cross and rose again three days later!

Through repentance and faith — trust Jesus Christ as your Saviour, and claim His promise of eternal life...

Romans 10:13, "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." This is a promise directly from God that if you will pray to Him, confess that you are a sinner, ask Him to forgive your sins, and accept Him as your Saviour — He promises to save you and give you the free gift of eternal life. Ephesians 2:8, "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: not of works, lest any man should boast." We are not saved by our good works. We are saved by the grace and mercy of God, when we put our faith in Christ.

"How many religions are there in the world? Hundreds? Perhaps thousands? Just trying to comprehend all the various belief systems and religious structures...can be mind boggling. Most people have their fair share of confusion and frustration trying to figure out which religion believes what and in what ways they are different.

In fact, it seems the latest craze is to just toss them all into the same category and say, "They're all the same. We're all going to the same place — just as long as we believe!" While that's convenient, it doesn't really make sense. What these religions believe from one to the next varies widely. In fact, some are diametrically opposed in belief. 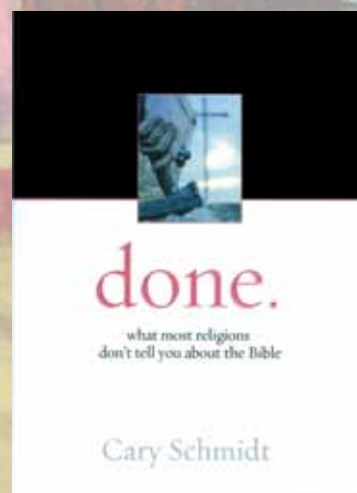

When Jesus was hanging on the cross He said these words, "It is finished" (John 19:30). The phrase literally means "paid in full." DONE. ...So, indeed there are just two religions in the world. DO and DONE..."
